To speak about the "German-way-of-life", the German habits, rules and laws, the German food and weather, the German holidays and its history, is also part of my classes.

At the beginning of the course we will also speak some English, but from lesson to lesson, and from chapter to chapter we will speak less and less English and more and more German until the students after one season will be able to even give a short talk/presentation in German.

The book that we are using is unfortunately out-of-print, but in my point of view and by all my experience it's still the best book available - in particular for beginners and for people who are not so much experienced in learning a foreign language.
